Appeal following the death of a child injured in Sudbury collision

Detectives are appealing for information after a child injured in a traffic collision in Sudbury has died from his injuries.

The child has been named as Qusai Alomar, he was aged 12 and was from the local area.

His family were informed and are being supported by specialist officers.

Police were called at 17:06hrs on Thursday, 16 September to Harrow Road,

Sudbury following reports of a road traffic collision involving a motorcycle and a pedestrian.

Officers and paramedics attended the scene.

Qusai was taken to hospital where he sadly died on Sunday, 19 September.

The rider of the motorcycle stopped at the scene.

No arrests have been made and enquiries continue.

Detectives from the Roads and Transport Policing Command are investigating.
