Charges following Tower Hamlets drugs raids

Ten men and two male youths have been charged with drug supply offences following the third phase of raids last month in Tower Hamlets.

On Wednesday, 27 June, search warrants were executed at addresses across the borough and in east London.

Those arrested were charged as below:

[A6] Noor Hussain, 21, (13.11.96) of Martineau Square, E1 was charged with the supply of cocaine and possession of criminal property. He has been remanded into custody to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 26 July.

[A7] A 15-year-old boy was charged with supplying cocaine. He was bailed to attend Stratford Youth Court on Thursday, 26 July.

[A8] Abdul Raihan, 25, (28.09.92) of Ben Johnson Road, E1 was charged with the supply of crack cocaine, the supply of heroin and being in possession of criminal property. He was released on conditional bail to return at a date at the end of July.

[A9] Ruhel Hussain, 18, (26.04.00) of Smithfield Court, Cable Street, E1 was charged with the supply of heroin, the supply of crack cocaine and possession with intent to supply crack cocaine. He will appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on conditional bail on Thursday, 26 July.

[A10] Shane Bates, 21, (22.10.96) of Cornwall Street, E1, was charged with the supply of crack cocaine, the supply of heroin, and possession with intent to supply Class A drugs (cocaine and heroin). He was released on conditional bail to return at a date at the end of July.

[A11] Abdul Samad, 21, (17.07.96) of Barnado Street, E1 was charged with the supply of crack cocaine and the supply of heroin. He was released on conditional bail to return at a date at the end of July.

[A12] Abdul Alim, 36, (25.10.81) of Albatross Close, E6 was charged with two counts of supplying crack cocaine and three counts with the supply of heroin. He was remanded into custody to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 26 July.

[A13] Ismail Kiani, 20, (09.10.97) of Campbell Road, E3 was charged with two counts of supplying crack cocaine and two counts of supplying heroin. He was remanded into custody to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 26 July.

[A14] Mohammed Rahman, 20, (18.01.98) of Geoff Cade Way, E3 was charged two counts of supplying crack cocaine and two counts of supplying heroin. He was released on conditional bail to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 26 July.

[A15] Adbul Hasnath 42, (14.12.75) of Hackney Road was charged with the supply of heroin, the supply of crack cocaine, possession with intent to

supply crack cocaine and possession of criminal property. He was remanded into custody to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 26 July.

[A16] Tahmid Hussain 21, (23.02.97) of The Quarterdeck, E14 was charged with the supply of crack cocaine and the supply of heroin. He pleaded guilty and was released on conditional bail. He will appear on conditional bail at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 5 July.

[A17] A 17-year-old boy was charged with three counts of supplying crack cocaine and three counts of supplying heroin. He was released on bail to appear at Thames Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 26 July.

A further ten men have also been charged with drug supply offences as part of the operation, they are:

[V] Mohibur Rahman, 22 (23.09.95) of St Paul's Way, E3 was charged on Wednesday, 6 June with the supply of crack cocaine, the supply of heroin and the supply of crack heroin. He pleaded guilty and is due to be sentenced at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Thursday, 5 July.

[W] Ahmadur Rahman, 21 (18.09.96) of no fixed address was charged on Monday, 11 June with the supply of crack cocaine and the supply of crack heroin. He has since pleaded guilty and will be sentenced on Thursday, 19 July at Snaresbrook Crown Court.

[X] Abdul Aziz 39 (29.09.78) of Miah Terrace, E3 was charged on Monday, 11 June with the supply of crack cocaine and the supply of crack heroin. He is remanded to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on Tuesday, 10 July.

[Y] Akbor Hussain, 24 (19.03.94) of Halley Street, E14 was charged on Tuesday, 12 June with the supply of crack cocaine, the supply of crack heroin and possession of criminal property. He is remanded to appear at Snaresbrook crown Court on a date to be confirmed.

[Z] Mahmudur Hassan, 23 (11.11.94) of Arbour Square, E1 was charged on Tuesday, 12 June with the supply of crack cocaine, the supply of crack heroin, possession with intent to supply Class A drugs (cocaine) and possession of a prohibited weapon. He was remanded to appear at Snaresbrook Crown Court on a date to be confirmed.

[A1] Samad Uddin, 28 (19.01.90) of Chicksand Street, E1 was charged on Wednesday, 20 June with the supply of crack cocaine, the supply of crack heroin, possession with intent to supply Class A drugs (cocaine and heroin) and possession of criminal property.
