UPDATE: Man charged with double murder in Ilford appears in court

A man charged with the murder of two men in Ilford has appeared in court.

Vytautas Garmus, 51 (04.07.69) of Prince Regent Lane, E13 appeared at Highbury Corner Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, 13 January charged with the murders of Dainius Kulboka, 44, and Jonas Semenas, 45.

He was remanded in custody to appear at the Old Bailey on Friday, 15 January.

+ Both victims were found suffering stab injuries at an address in Tavistock

Gardens, Ilford on Sunday, 10 January.

Post mortem examinations at East Ham Mortuary on Tuesday, 12 January gave cause of death for both men as stab injuries.

Both the deceased are Lithuanian nationals – their next of kin have been informed.

Garmus is a Georgian national.
